

## ACCESSIBILITY STATEMENT

This statement applies to the Mobberley Parish Council Website [www.mobberleyparishcouncil.co.uk](http://www.mobberleyparishcouncil.co.uk)

The website has been created and managed by Mobberley Parish Council. The Council want as many people as possible to be able to use this website.
