

It was suggested that the Rose Queen committee be approached about putting their marquee and stage up two weeks early so that it can be utilized for any Jubilee celebrations. The Scout Hut field could then be used for a picnic in the park on the Sunday. One of the marquees would have children's entertainment and the Guides / Scouts or school would be approached to organise this.

Anne will liaise with Mobberley Ice Cream Company and Sister Barista as to whether they would like to have a stand at the event.

A service will be organised at St Wilfrid's for the Sunday evening to finish off the weekend.

An article will go in the newsletter with the outline of the plans and asking whether there are any local singers or entertainers who would be free to perform on the Sunday.

It was suggested that the school, Brownies and Cubs be approached as to whether they can produce Jubilee related decorations for the village.
