## Village Events Committee Meeting Minutes Monday 13<sup>th</sup> March 2023 at 19:00

Agenda:

1. **Apologies for absence:** None.
2. **To note any declaration(s) of interest:** None
3. **To approve and sign the minutes of the meeting on 30<sup>th</sup> January 2023:** The minutes were approved and signed.
4. **Public Participation:** Bouncy Bouncy discussed the events that their services would be hired for. Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> May, a projection would be put at the Bulls Head of the Coronation Concert at the Palace and a kids' film would be screened in the afternoon using the same screen. A power point within 25 metres would be needed. Hannah will check the Wi-Fi connection at the Bulls Head and report back prior to Bouncy Bouncy going down to check how the space would work for the screens.  
24<sup>th</sup> June, Mobb Fest – hiring of a small screen for a kid's film and hiring of the football kickout.  
16<sup>th</sup> July Sports Day – hiring of the football kickout. A generator would be needed for this. Duncan will speak to the Mobberley Football Club about putting a junior match on in the afternoon.  
Rajar main hall and outside space – Bouncy Bouncy would look at dressing the room for the relaunch of the space.  
The Body Shop representative was interested in attending the event on the Lady's Night event on 21<sup>st</sup> October and having a stall.  
A table top sale at the Rajar was discussed where stallholders would sell their wares.  
Mobberley Methodist would like to get involved in more community events.
5. **Easter Egg Hunt:** Monday 10<sup>th</sup> April, 1.30 on the Community Meadow. The Methodist would like to offer volunteers for the event. If the weather is set to rain the Methodist will offer their building for the egg hunt.
6. **Coronation Weekend:** Friday 5<sup>th</sup> May – the Royal Tea Party will be at the Rajar. Subject to getting the National Lottery grant, this will be a free event for 40 elderly residents.  
Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> May 11am – orienteering on the Community Meadow and around Mobberley to finish at King Charlie's Chippy for a bag of chips.  
Evening of May 6<sup>th</sup> is the Royal Knees Up at the Victory Hall. Tickets are selling well. There are 250 tickets available. There will be a royal dress Up theme.  
Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> – screening of the Jubilee Concert at the Bulls Head.  
Monday 8<sup>th</sup> – Volunteering Day. Bulbs for the school children will be flowers from the emblem.
7. **Review of budget position:** The budget position for the remainder of the financial year was discussed.
8. **Any other business:** The dog walks are going to carry on for the foreseeable every other week. These will be on a Wednesday afternoon at 4.30pm.  
Book Club is going to run on a Thursday evening at the Rajar each month.
