- Community Meadow: A revised plan is being drawn for the proposed path. Once the plans have been drafted a planning application will be applied for. Manchester Airport are planting 50 trees on the Meadow on the 18th November. They are sending a team down to do the planting.
- 4. Highways: Anne has attended a 20 is Plenty meeting with Cheshire East the aim is to put all current 30 mile an hour areas in Cheshire East to a 20 is Plenty zone. In such zones accidents have decreased by 43%. Cheshire East would like all parish councils to take a motion that states that they support the 20 is Plenty campaign so that they can take this county wide. Cheshire East spoke also about the Speed Cam Anywhere app that members of the public to take date stamped, speed stamped footage that is sent to the police. A discussion took place about the Average Speed Camera pilot project which is in its first year in Plumley. Further information about the costings for the project will be required if the pilot scheme is rolled out. Peaks and Plains are sending out an engineer to look at the potholes at the entrance to Hall Bank.
- 5. **Footpaths:** Cheshire East have given a stile kit and a kissing gate to fix the broken stiles that are dangerous in the village. The Parish Ranger is going to do the work and Cheshire East have confirmed that they will reimburse the Parish Council for the time taken to carry this work out.
