Mobberley Primary School

Reception enjoyed a visit from Mr Johnston who is a pilot. As part of their topic 'Are we there yet?' Mr Johnston told the children all about his job. He explained how maps and weather charts are really important to pilots and gave some information about how planes fly!

Year 1 have been learning all about the Great Fire of London. They were astonished to find out that Samuel Pepys buried cheese and wine in his garden to protect it from the fire!

Year 2 have been using writing algorithms and designing mats to programme the Dash robots to travel along the route.

Year 3 found a dragon egg under a tree! As part of their English topic, they received a letter from a dragonologist explaining how to look after the dragon when it hatches. Year 4 have been writing information texts about torches. They have created their own electrical circuits and will use these to create their own torches in Design Technology.

Year 5 have been reading about Henry Brown and how he escaped from slavery by mailing himself in a box. They will be writing biographies and diary extracts inspired by Henry.

Year 6 have been writing their own folktales based on local folktales they have been reading. The legend of Alderley Edge has provided a lot of the inspiration for their work.

The whole school enjoyed a fitness day delivered by Goodness to Greatness. The children enjoyed making and tasting smoothies as well as designing a balanced plate of food.

The whole school also received a visit from PCSO Emma Darroch as part of Safer Internet day. They learnt how to stay safe on the internet and designed posters giving advice to others.




Notification of Runway Closure 2022

I hope that this New Year finds you fit and well.

As you may be aware, our existing Runway, Runway 1 (05R/23L) is our primary runway and has been used solely for operations during the Pandemic where we have been operating with severely restricted aircraft movements. Each year maintenance work is required to maintain Runway 1, the most used runway, and its' adjoining taxiways. We publish dates of the nights when Runway 1 will be closed;
