## Hedgehog Highway Surrounds Giveaway

With hedgehog numbers in decline and hedgehog awareness on the rise, there has never been a better time to get involved in hedgehog conservation. A hedgehog highway is a 5 inch gap in a fence and is essential in the battle to prevent the extinction of our endangered spiky friends. This gap allows them access to forage for food and meet mates. Mobberley Parish Council have 50 highway surrounds to giveaway. These surrounds enable you to measure the hole that is needed in the fence, they look cute and they create a talking point, encouraging others to build a highway of their own.

We are creating a hedgehog display on the noticeboard at the Rajar Building. We are looking for residents help to fill the board with fabulous photographs, drawings, paintings, in exchange for a highway surround and information leaflet.

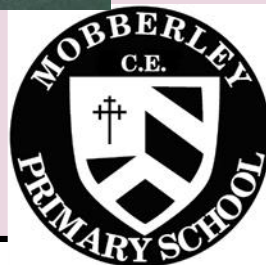

## **MANCHESTER AIRPORT**

Following the easing of travel restrictions on 11<sup>th</sup> February, passenger numbers continue to grow at Manchester Airport. To allow for the additional flight movements, the airport is set to reopen Runway Two from Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> April. Initially it will operate for a limited number of hours each day and will gradually increase as the demand continues to rise.

**Karen Smart, Managing Director of Manchester Airport, said:**

“After almost two years of closure, it is a positive step forward on the road to recovery to be able to reopen Runway Two.

“It’s a clear sign of the pent-up demand there is from our passengers and the eagerness to travel now restrictions have been eased further.

### **Notification of Runway Closure 2022**

As you may be aware, our existing Runway, Runway 1 (05L/23R) is our primary runway and has been used solely for operations during the Pandemic where we have been operating with severely restricted aircraft movements.

Each year maintenance work is required to maintain Runway 1, the most used runway, and its’ adjoining taxiways. We publish dates of the nights when Runway 1 will be closed;

September 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>, 22:30 – 6:00

October 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>, 22:30 – 6:00

November 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>, 22:30 – 6:00

December 6<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>, 22:30 – 6:00

After many years without a junior football club in Mobberley, Mobberley Junior Football Club was founded in 2016. It all began with 6 budding 8yr olds (including my own son) and me!

At 38yrs young I had always wanted to try my hand at coaching having been coached by my father as a young boy. With no spaces available at Egerton FC or Wilmslow Town at the time, I decided to approach the local parish council for support in the forming of a Mobberley team - luckily they were only too happy to help!

Within a few months I had gained my FA Level 1 coaching badge along with the necessary safeguarding and emergency first aid certificates, to get us going. With a bag of size 3 footballs and a box of cones, training commenced every Saturday morning on the Ilford playing field. Fast forward 12months and we already had enough players to field both an Under 9's team and an Under 7's team!

Further support and sponsorship came from the Bulls Head, Mobberley, enabling us to purchase our first kits!! Since then we have become affiliated with the Timperley and District league and we are also accredited as an FA Charter Standard Club.

Today the club continues to grow with its own website, Facebook and Instagram pages and now into our seventh year we have over 10 coaches, 5 teams and more than 70 players!!

Last season brought 3 Trophies to the village - 3 cup wins as well as one of our teams coming runners-up in their division - a great feat for our little village and great plaudits must go to the spirit of the players, parents and in particular the coaches and committee.

Special thanks must go out to all the coaches, volunteers, and sponsors who together have enable the club to not only be a fabulous success but have also ensured the financial stability of the club today and for the foreseeable future....
