# **Mobberley Primary School**

There have been so many things going on at Mobberley Primary School since our last contribution to this newsletter.

In November we celebrated anti-bullying week with the theme 'reach out'. We learnt how we could reach out to one another if we spotted bullying at our school. Children wore odd socks to celebrate the week and designed posters as part of a school competition. All year groups enjoyed an assembly led by the PCSO about staying safe, as well as a drama workshop led by Altru theatre.

In December, everyone was very busy practising for their nativities. Singing and performing is an integral part of school life at Mobberley, both during the school day and at the weekend. Our wonderful choir have recently performed at the Christmas Fair, Manchester Airport, Sunrise nursing home and at St Wilfrid's Church. The Reception class performed their first nativity in the hall to many proud parents and did so well to remember all the words to the songs! Years 1 – 6 performed in their various nativities at St Wilfrid's Church and brought many laughs and happy tears! Amongst the other Christmas activities, children enjoyed a Christmas dinner in school, Christmas jumper day and a visit to/from the pantomime. The Juniors watched Alice in Wonderland at the New Vic Theatre and the infant children watched Aladdin in the school hall. We also want to think the many generous families who contributed a shoebox to the Operation Christmas Child appeal. The kind donations were sent to a number of countries, but mostly to children in Ukraine.

Our first week back after the Christmas holidays saw children learning all about STEM. Each class was challenged to pose a question and research the answer. Children's questions ranged from 'How do bees make honey?' to 'What are the dangers of black holes?' They then presented their findings to their parents — many of whom were very impressed! Children also enjoyed a Science show, which involved investigations such as which is the most dunkable biscuit and what happens if we put mentos in lemonade. In addition, pupils were challenged to continue their research at home and create posters, videos and PowerPoints about their learning, with prizes for the winners.

As always, we have many exciting things coming up and we can't wait to see what the rest of 2023 brings us.






















