AN UPDATE FROM TATTON PARK

Tatton Park are putting in place a temporary restriction across Tatton Park insisting that all dogs are on leads until 31st July.

We have had 4 major incidents relating to dog attacks in the past week on baby deer calves, chasing of pregnant hinds which can lead to still birth and also an attack on the sheep.

This will be communicated by signage at the walking entrances and car entry points, an update on the website, plus a small leaflet handed to dog walkers arriving by car.

Messy Church has now broken up for the summer and will restart, at The Beacon, on **Saturday 30th September** at 10.00 a.m.

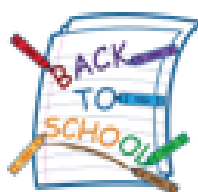

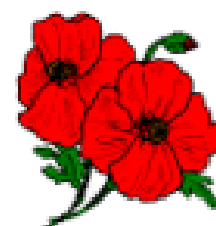

Mobberley Primary School

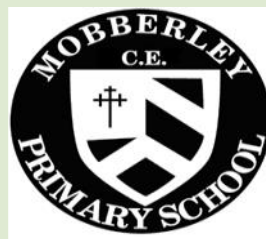
