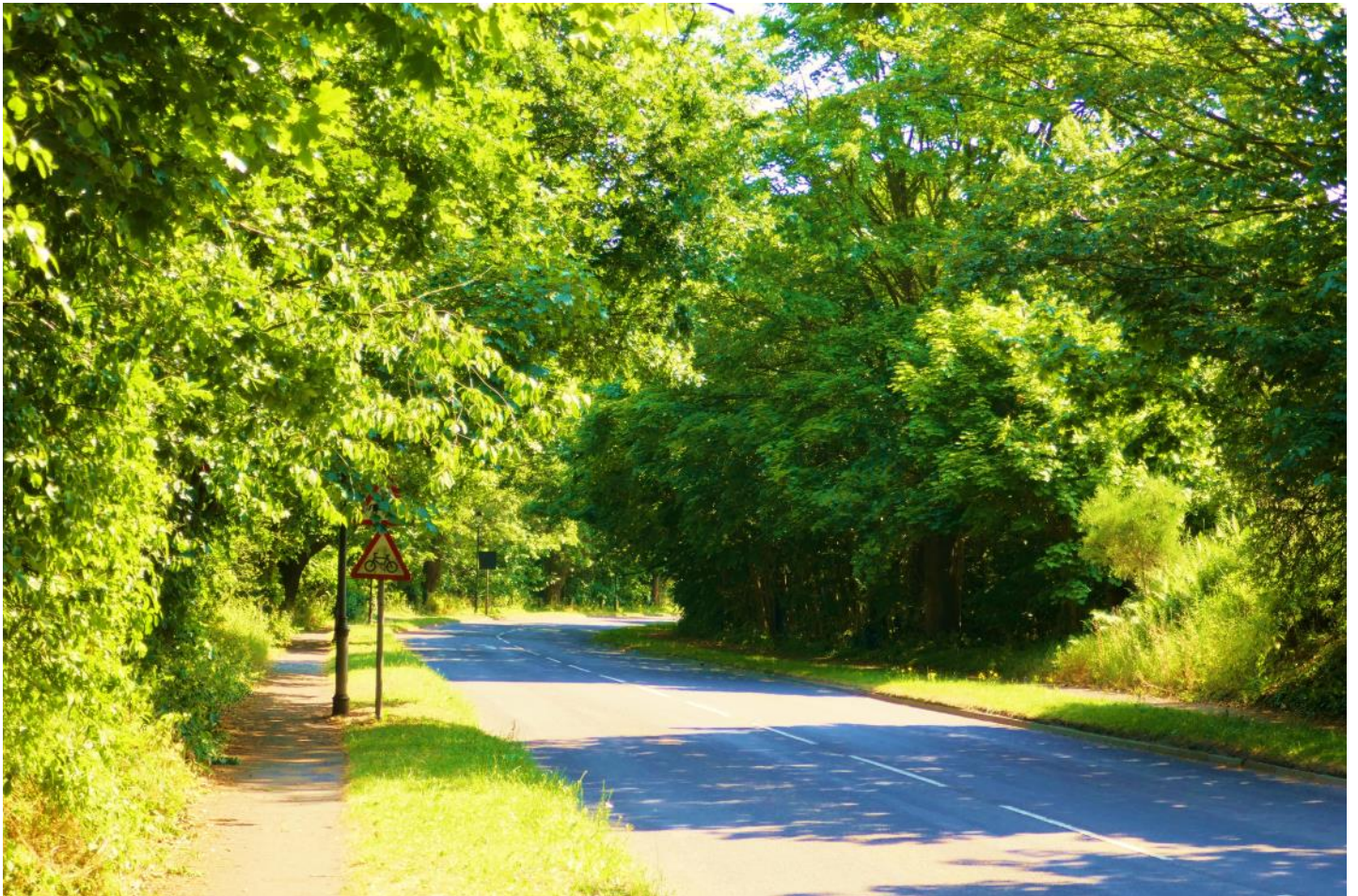

TOUR OF BRITAIN

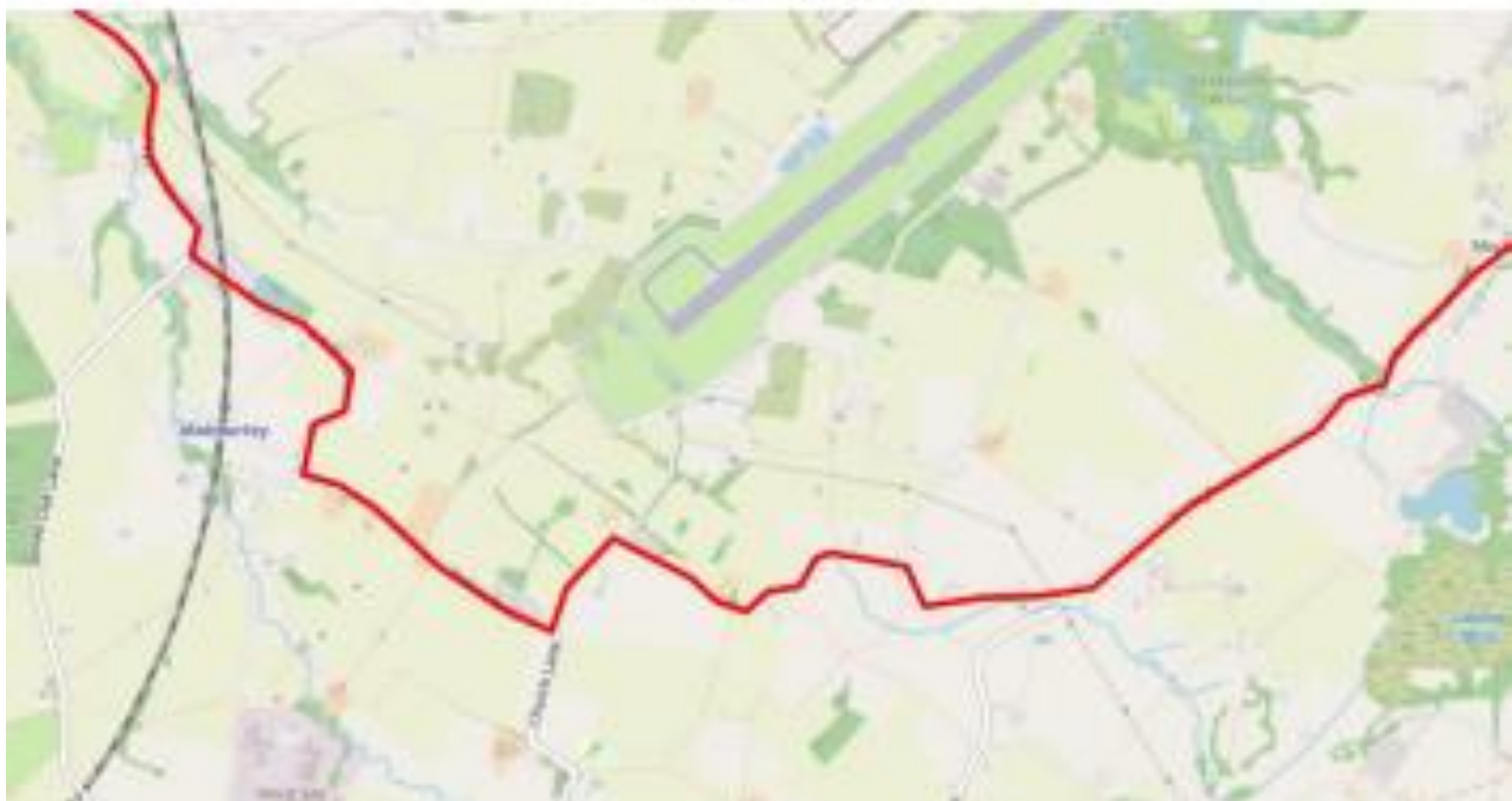


Once again, Cheshire East will witness Tour of Britain action as many of the world's top cyclists take to our roads.

Starting at 11.45am on Sunday 3 September, in Altrincham, the first stage of the event will see the field travelling at speeds of more than 30mph, negotiating hump-back railway bridges and testing bends through Ashley and Mobberley.

The tour will follow a 12-mile route through Cheshire East starting from the border with Trafford at Ashley, then heading south into Mobberley, before turning northeast to travel through Wilmslow, Dean Row and onto Stockport.

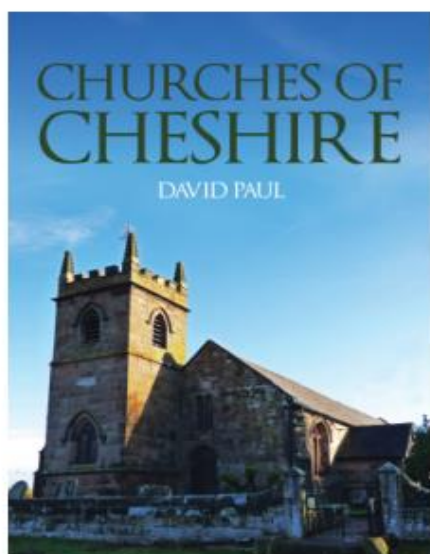

September 17th. We welcome our Circuit Superintendent Rev. Alan Bradley.

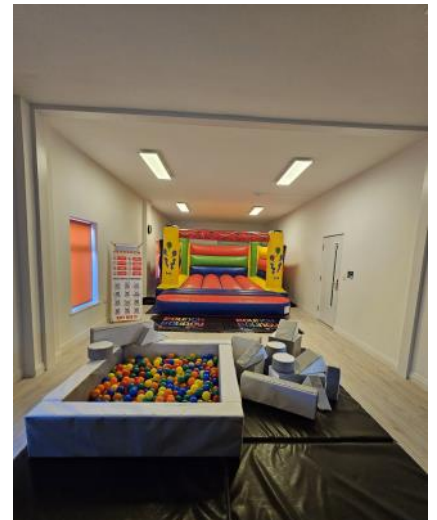

Year 5 went to Knutsford Academy on a PE transition day and Year 6 cricketers took part in the county finals.

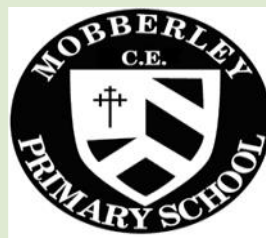

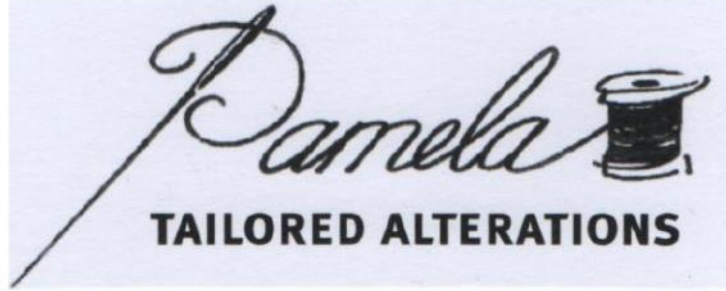
