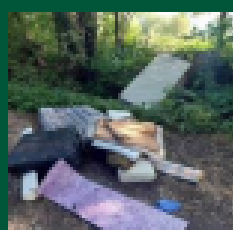

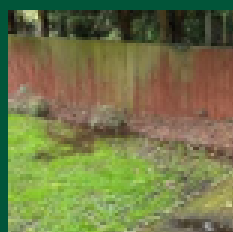

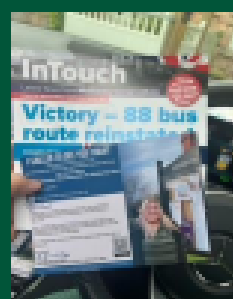


Multiple reports of fly tipping have been reported throughout August and September. Cheshire East were quick to respond and the debris was cleared quickly.

## Visit to the Somme by Alistair MacLeod

Fifty one men with links to Mobberley lost their lives in World War 1. Of these, twenty seven did so while stationed on the part of the front we know as the Somme. Nearly all of these died in the First Battle of the Somme, the Battle of Arras and in the defence against the German Spring Offensive in March 1918 and the subsequent advance to Victory. These men were all either volunteers or later conscripts from a Mobberley village that was much smaller than today, with a total population of under one thousand five hundred - the impact must have been significant. Hall Bank lost three men at numbers 3, 4 and 10.



The area in France we're talking about is relatively small, defined broadly by Arras, Amiens and Cambrai. Some men are only remembered on the great memorials at Thiepval and Arras as their bodies were never found or identified. Those that have visited some of the cemeteries maintained by the Commonwealth War Graves Commission will know how moving the experience can be with so many scattered across France and Belgium (and other parts of the world).

In August I managed to visit all of these Somme locations and left comments in the visitors' books usually held at each cemetery as many of these men will now have no relatives aware of a distant Great or Great-Great Uncle and it is important that they are not completely forgotten.

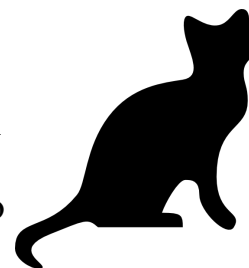

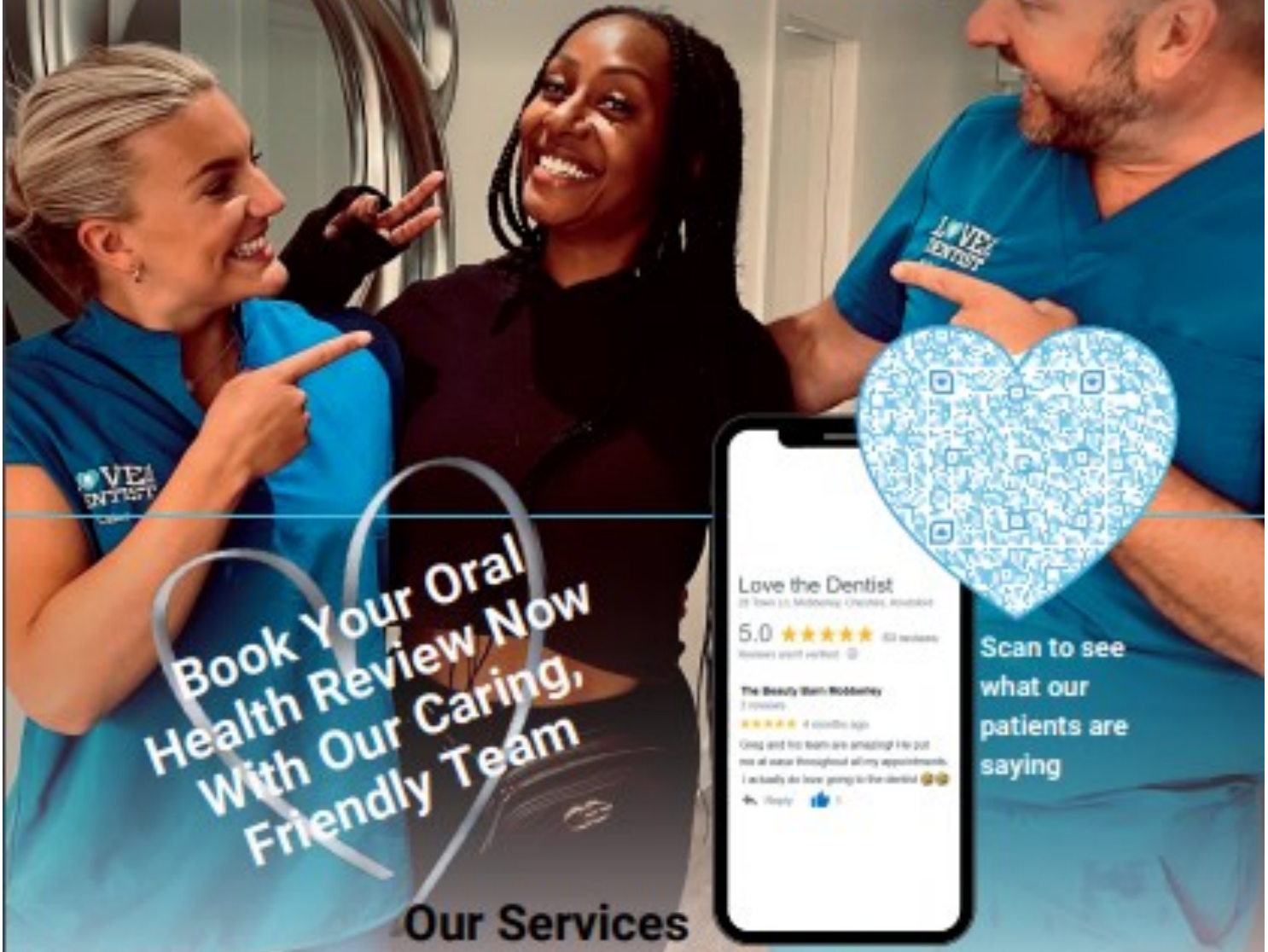
